

GLYC Sailboat Checkout Program

The sailboat checkout program allows GLYC adult or junior members to skipper Club-owned sailboats on Gull Lake. All sailors must be certified by GLYC before checking out Club boats. Certification factors in experience and/or outside certifications from other programs at the discretion of the commodore and program director.

To request certification, first familiarize yourself with the GLYC Adult Sailing Checkout Program Procedures, Club Boat Equipment, and the Rigging Instructions (see below). Then fill out and submit a Checkout Application Form (also below).

Once certified you must use the Checkout Request form in order to reserve the boat requested. Checkout is on a first come first served basis based on the Request Form.

Sailors who participate in the Checkout Program are responsible for any damage caused to the Club boats used.

Equipment

The GLYC owns and maintains three Flying Scots, which are parked in the dry sail parking lot on trailers in the row of boats closest to the mast stepper.

The Club owns and maintains six 420s.

Adult sailors must have Coast Guard approved Type III personal flotation devices with them at all times while aboard Club owned boats. Children six and younger must wear their life jackets at all times while aboard Club owned boats. Sailors are encouraged to

purchase their own life vests. There are some life preservers in the Sailing Storage Box that are available for use.
